Pen y Cymoedd Wind Farm Community Fund recognises and values the benefits of community managed playgrounds and can consider applications for equipment and site development.

In addition to meeting general Fund requirements, any proposal would need to demonstrate that:

- Best practice guidance published by the Royal Society for the Prevention of Accidents (RoSPA) [Play Safety Department](#) has been followed and fully taken into account
- Quotes have been obtained from suppliers who are registered with the [Association of Play Industries](#)
- A risk assessment has taken place for the installation
- The needs of children and young people with disabilities have been considered and taken into account
- RoSPA post-installation inspection and sign-off will take place. You can include the cost of this in your application.
- Plans to undertake regular inspection and maintenance are in place – along with the resources needed to carry them out
- An annual independent inspection will take place and resources are in place to enable this to happen
