Community Profile – Rhigos, Cefn Rhigos and Penderyrn

Introduction from the community

Overview

Rhigos is a village in the north of the Cynon valley. It comes under the town of Aberdare for postal purposes, even though it is seven miles away and is closer to Glynneath, which is only two miles away. Cefn Rhigos is to the west of the village of Rhigos and is the most westerly village within the Cynon valley. The border of the Vale of Neath only lies a few hundred yards away from the village. The Tower Colliery was located on the Rhigos Mountain and closed in 2008 - the last of the deep mines in Wales to close.

Penderyn is a rural village in the <u>Cynon Valley</u> and is within the Rhigos ward. It is located near <u>Hirwaun</u>. Its origins and expansion begun as an agricultural market village, which supplied the ever growing needs of the nearby local Market Town of <u>Aberdare</u>, situated in the <u>Cynon Valley</u>. It lies on the <u>A4059 road</u> between Hirwaun and <u>Brecon</u> and is the last settlement on that road in the county of <u>Rhondda Cynon Taf</u> before the border with <u>Powys</u> to the north. The village sits just within the southern boundary of the <u>Brecon Beacons National Park</u>. The <u>River Cynon</u> passes through the area. Penderyn is an area of agriculture and hosts seasonal markets. Penderyn Quarry located in the village is an operating quarry capable of producing 500,000 tonnes of limestone per year.

The Rhigos ward is in the most northerly part of the Cynon valley, and has a rural feel. With a small population of 1,769 residents, the main buildings used for the communities are the Penderyn Community Centre and the Rhigos Sports Association Hall. The area has a beautiful landscape, there are campsites and bed and breakfasts available. Penderyn is famous for having the only single malt whiskey distillery in Wales.

It was built as a relief project for unemployed miners and opened in November 1929. It now serves as main access road for those working in Cynon, Rhondda, Neath and Swansea valleys. Exiting off the A465 onto the A4059 will lead into Penderyn. Rail Aberdare railway station is the last stop on the transport for Wales line, which runs from Cardiff. There are on average 8

For more information on activities based in all these buildings, see Section 1	 Llyn Fawr Reservoir (angling run by Upper Rhondda Angling Association) – is a reservoir in the south of the Rhigos which lies in the Craig-y- llyn, an area which is a designated site for special scientific interest. It lies near the source of the Rhondda River Fawr. The reservoir contains many objects from the Bronze age and several iron objects. A sword found is said to be the earliest iron object that has been found in Wales, dating back to 650 BC. The Penderyn quarry line - This quiet route is ideal for spotting local wildlife as well as evidence of industrial and social history. The route follows an old tramway that runs from Penderyn to Hirwaun which linked the limestone quarry to the ironworks. The route has a gentle compacted stone surface, but it can get muddy in places after long spells of rain. There are also anti- motorcycle barriers at either end of the trail and at points along the trail. The Penderyn Quarry Line leaflet contains details on wildlife and historical features.
