



What is match funding?

Any money that you bring to the project that reduces how much you are asking us for. This could be money from your own reserves, money you have or will fundraise, other grants you have secured or are applying for money you will raise in running the activity.

Does Pen y Cymoedd require match funding? No, we do not have a minimum level of match funding we require but of course any application to the fund is far stronger if there is an element of match funding.

Why do funders like match funding? It not only helps us distribute the money we have available to support more organisations and businesses, but it also shows us that you, as a business or organisation, are dedicated to the project. In situations where you have raised money through crowd funding or community fundraising, it truly demonstrates the support of the larger community for your activity.

What could count as match funding?

- 1. Your own reserves
- 2. Money you have fundraised through events, activities, raffles etc
- 3. Other grants
- 4. Donations
- 5. Crowd funding
- 6. Money you have recently already invested
- 7. For events etc it could be anticipated ticket sales
- 8. For businesses it could be bank or business loans
